Since 1885, HumanKind Ministries has brought the Wichita community together to serve those living in poverty.

Today that work includes providing outreach, shelter, affordable housing, basic needs, and supportive services to those who need it most. Each year, HK serves between 1,200 and 1,500 unduplicated homeless men, women, and children in our Emergency Winter Shelters and year-round homeless shelter, The Inn—plus between 12,000 and 15,000 men, women, and children in Sedgwick County through Operation Holiday, the region's largest holiday assistance program.

Additionally, HumanKind offers 155 affordable and safe permanent supportive housing units to help low-income and formerly homeless individuals and families find stability and self-sufficiency.
